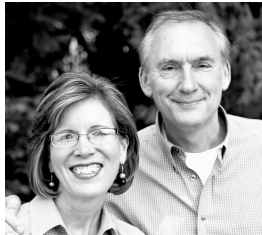


Holy Calling in the Workplace
